Extra:

Before the Deployment Stage, players must decide who is player A and who is B in order to determine the extra they may apply to their Army Lists.

PLAYER A: this player's Army List must have 250 points and 5 SWC. He can add a Tikbalang, Acontecimento Chasseurs to his Army List with no SWC cost. This Tikbalang will represent Eduardo.

PLAYER B: this player's Army List must have 350 points and 7 SWC.

If one of the players plays with the Combined Army or any of its Sectorials, he will automatically be Player B.
